## Wisconsin Junior Simmental Association

### Show steer of the Year 2019

#### Rules

This competition is designed to recognize and reward the accomplishments of junior Simmental members over their show year.

1. Each junior member may enter up to two (2) show steers per year. For points to be valid, the animal must be exhibited by the junior member that submits the form. The animal will be ranked based on the score they earn from the points obtained from each show.

**2. NOTICE: To enter the WJSA Show Steer of the Year Contest, student must be a paid Wisconsin Jr. Simmental Association member in good standing.**

3. Any Steer that was born from September 2017 – April 2019 is eligible to be entered into the competition.

4. Attached you will find the points allotted for certain placing at shows. The show divisions include: Major/National Level Shows, Regional Level Shows, State Level Shows, County Level Shows and Preview/Jackpot Level Shows. The shows eligible in each of these two levels will be indicated. All shows including open shows are eligible for this competition, include the open shows as long as the Junior was showing the animal themselves.

5. The animal will earn the point values for the level of accomplishment reached. For example if you showed your heifer at your county fair and she was Reserve Supreme Champion, you will receive that level of points not adding points together below as years past which caused confusion in point totals.

6. All bred & owned animals are also eligible to add points earned in bred & owned classes. These points are listed below. Bred & owned points may be used **ONLY** if the animal was shown in a class where bred & owned animals were recognized and exhibited by the junior member that submits the form.

7. The top 3 Simmental steers in the state of Wisconsin will be awarded at the Wisconsin Simmental Association Spring Banquet.

8. The forms must be completely filled out and submitted to WSA Board Member, Devin Hadorn-Papke on or before February 20, 2020. If any forms are submitted after the deadline or are incomplete in any way they will be disqualified. The forms need to be submitted along with a photo of the animal entered.
